

BIBLIOGRAPHY OF CANADIAN EDUCATIONAL HISTORY/BIBLIOGRAPHIE D'HISTOIRE DE L'ÉDUCATION CANADIENNE

In this issue we continue the bibliography on Canadian educational history and related fields which was last updated in the *CHEA Bulletin d'ACHE* IV, 3 (Oct./oct. 1987). The bibliography attempts in particular to list periodical articles, essays in monographs, and other items which may escape a literature search more readily than monographs themselves.
