Founding Conference

The Founding Conference of the Ontario Women's History Network took place on Saturday, 3 February 1990, in Toronto.

The origins of the Network lie in two meetings, in the spring and fall of 1989, at which a group of interested persons—teachers, librarians, researchers, historians, and archivists—gathered to discuss ways to bridge the current “gaps” between research and public education in the field of women's history. These meetings identified three areas in particular to focus on: teaching, research, and public accessibility.

The agenda at the founding conference featured a keynote address by Wendy Mitchinson, of the Department of History, University of Waterloo. Morning and afternoon workshops addressed two areas of public accessibility, community awareness and curriculum materials, and covered such topics as walking tours, study groups, community research (multicultural and native studies), curriculum development for secondary schools, community resources, and franco-ontarian distance education.

A constitution was adopted and a slate of directors elected: Alison Prentice (Chair), Barbara Craig (Deputy Chair), Paula Bourne (Secretary), Pat Staton (Treasurer), Jane Errington and Elizabeth Smyth (directors at large).

The Network is planning further meetings and a future conference. Membership is open to anyone interested in any aspect of women's history. We

Manuscripts in English should be sent to R.D. Gidney or R. Coulter, Co-editor, *Historical Studies in Education*, Faculty of Education, The University of Western Ontario, London, Ontario, Canada, N6G 1G7. Manuscripts in French should be sent to R. Heap, Rédactrice adjointe, *Revue d'histoire de l'éducation*, Département d'histoire, Université d'Ottawa, Ottawa, Ontario, Canada, K1N 6N5. Text and endnotes should be double-spaced. For English manuscripts, follow *Chicago Manual of Style*, 13th edition, and *Oxford English Dictionary* spelling. French manuscripts should follow Eugénie Lévesque, *Guide d'Édition* (Québec: Éditeur officiel du Québec, 1980). Both English and French manuscripts should also follow, as a supplement for specifically Canadian usage, *The Canadian Style; A Guide to Writing and Editing* (Toronto and London: Dundurn Press in co-operation with the Department of the Secretary of State of Canada, 1985)/*Guide du rédacteur de l'administration fédérale* (Ottawa: Direction de l'information, Bureau des traductions, 1983). Three paper copies should be submitted. Authors whose manuscripts are accepted for publication will be asked to supply a copy on diskette, preferably IBM, or IBM-compatible (MS-DOS).

This journal supports the elimination of sexual, racial, and ethnic stereotyping and refers all potential authors to the appropriate guidelines in *The Canadian Style/Guide du rédacteur*.

Submission of a manuscript implies that it is not being considered for publication elsewhere.

Labour/Le Travail is the official publication of the Committee on Canadian Labour History. Since it began publishing in 1976, it has carried many important articles in the field of working-class history, industrial sociology, labour economics, and labour relations. Although primarily interested in a historical perspective on Canadian workers, the journal is interdisciplinary in scope. In addition to articles, the journal features documents, conference reports, an annual bibliography of materials in Canadian labour studies, review essays, and reviews. While the main focus of the journal's articles is Canadian, the review essays and reviews consider international work of interest to Canadian labour studies. Many of *Labour's* articles are illustrated.
